

Patient Monitoring Capabilities

- Identifying patients at risk for poor outcomes
- Managing drugs with medical and pharmacy components (ex: IV to SubQ care coordination)
- Tracking and reporting specific patient populations
- Coordinating monitoring requirements

Infusion to SubQ Care Coordination



Focus on External Partnerships

- Limited Distribution Network Pilot Programs
- Dedicated teams to enhance patient/provider journey (infusion PharmDs, REMS team, Data Analytics)
- Case managers, social workers, and financial counselors

Collaboration with a Specialty Pharmacy Nursing Network Available

- National network that can service patients outside of our regional area
- VSP provides the medication and the nursing network provides the nurse to administer the medication

• Tailored protocols for treatment initiation and ongoing monitoring

Collaborative Pharmacy Practice Agreements

- Legal agreement that authorizes pharmacists to care for patients under the supervision of a provider, including refilling medications and labs
